Re: Fall 2022 Report

The last public program was on February 4 by Warren Sibilla. After that all programming was suspended until January of 2023.

The Committee resumed planning meetings in August and is monitoring the availability of office personnel to handle registrations and any needs for ZOOM management. As soon as these are in place we will be prepared to offer some programs. The committee is considering the following:

1. Community Day has been set for March 18, Saturday. The speaker will be Steve Buser and the subject will be the collected works of Marie Louise von Franz. Dr. Buser is a psychiatrist and graduate of our JPP program. Schedule and venue are being planned.
2. An in- person small workshop/conversation on "Agism" which exams the images of aging embedded in contemporary movies. He will assert and illustrate with film clips how most film perspectives on aging are those of young people, not those of seniors. The Presenter will be James Vanden Bosch, a film maker for Terra Nova Films, and a film reviewer for Gerontology Magazine.
3. Education/Consultation Workshops of varying lengths, mostly done by ZOOM and aimed at clinicians.
4. Reading/Discussion Groups both on-line and in-person on such books as "Women Who Run with the Wolves," "The Mystical Exodus in Jungian Perspective," or "Absent Father Effect on Daughters."
5. A Video project involving the taping of small groups of analysts talking about how training to be an analyst has transformed their personal lives and their clinical practice. This project is not in the Public Program Budget and will cost between \$10,000 and \$15,000 to film and edit. The aim is to provide personal stories for clinicians who are considering getting analytic training. This aims to answer a question often raised in the JPP about the benefits of analytic training when the costs are very high. The hope is to post these group interviews on the Institute Web site.

6. The MDR program is on hold and remains under the oversight of the Program Committee. When this program can be offered again depends upon having an analyst to direct it.
7. The creation of podcast interviews under the direction of Ben Law and Patricia Martin (JSP 2018) continues as resources are available. These podcasts continue to attract many viewers to the Institute website.
