# Report from Ad Hoc Committee to Study Increases in Program Fees To the Board of the C.G. Jung of Chicago

This proposal came as a request by the Institute Board to research the possibility of raising fees for both the Analyst Training Program (ATP) and the Jungian Psychotherapy and Jungian Studies Programs (JPP & JSP)<sup>1</sup> and to propose a policy for an automatic yearly adjustment for inflation.

This proposal is intended to provide a justification for a fee increase applied to both training programs. It will then be presented first to the Executive Committee at the July 27<sup>th</sup> meeting for approval then to both the Institute Board and the CSJA meetings in September so that new fees can be approved and the new fee structure be in place and incorporated into the JSP/JPP applications.

The Ad Hoc Committee recommends an initial and immediate increase in program fees of 10% to account for cost-of-living increases for the last four years during which time there was no increase, while the increase in the cost of living has been 16.4%. After that we recommend a 2-5% increase in fees to be reassessed each year and approved by the Program Directors if less than 5%. If greater than 5% then also to be approved by the CSJA. There are no comparable JPP/JSP programs to compare cost but we did compare ATP costs with several other programs including, the Inter-Regional Society of Jungian Analysts, the C.G. Jung Institute of New York, The Jung Institute in Ontario and the C. G. Jung Institute of New England. On average the Chicago program charged less.

We discussed the potential burden this increase would place on Mexican students already in the program and we recommended that be addressed by the ATP Training Committee and each situation evaluated individually.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The Institute plan is for both programs to continue. The JPP and JSP has one more year of training for its current cohort which will end in June of 2023. There is a question whether the on-line program called MDR (Memories, Dreams, Reflections) will be run after the 2021-2023 cohort is completed before another JPP/JSP cohort is started, which would put the next JPP/JSP in the fall of 2024. The other option is to run the next JPP/JSP cohort in the fall of 2023. In either case, another JPP/JSP cohort is planned.

#### Motion:

Tuition for the *Memories, Dreams, Reflections* Course, the JPP/JSP, and ATP will increase by 10%, beginning with the cohort entering in the fall of 2023. This takes into account that there was no tuition increase during the past four years, while the increase in the cost of living was 16.4%. In each subsequent year, a 2-5% increase in fees will reassessed and approved by the Program Directors if 5% or less. If greater than 5% is recommended, then it should also be approved by the CSJA.
